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As we all know about living in Minnesota, the winter season is here, it can be fun but also dangerous. The cold temperatures bring us snow, freezing rain, and ice with a chance of some slips and falls. Falls are a major threat to our health. From injuries sustained during these accidents to subsequent complications, spills on snow and ice can have dire consequences for any of us. We can all start with having the proper warm clothing from jackets, hats, gloves, scarves, and footwear. Comfortable, waterproof, non-skid soles, shoes, or boots. If we use a walking aide or a cane it is good practice to have our staff or a family member check the handles, wheels, bottom grippers, breaks and bottom pads to be sure they are not worn out, have good traction are in good working condition. Repair or replace any worn out or damaged part as soon as possible. We can avoid walking on ice and snow. Stay inside until conditions improve and snow clean up is complete. When we must go outside, remember to dress for the weather. If conditions are slippery, use the assistance of an escort or family member, walk with a sidestep or like a penguin with short, slow strides, legs shoulder width apart and knees slightly bent for good balance. Take advantage of the cleared sidewalks and driveways, always walk around an ice or slippery spot if your able to. Be aware of black ice and please be extremely careful outside. We will do our best to make sure the walkways and driveways are cleared and remain safe this winter season.
